Chuck presented a PowerPoint giving an overview of the advances in technology since the 1st Industrial Revolution. He also explained the difference between (IT) Information Technology which is the application of technology to solve business or organizational problems and (OT) Operational Technology which is hardware and software that detects, monitors, or causes a change, through the communication with industrial control equipment, assets, processes, or events. We are now in the middle of the 4th Industrial Revolution from the early 2000s until now. Currently, OT and IT are converging with the shift of the integration of smart automation and technology. ADP is currently migrating Cisco phones across the County to a Cloud based phone system. Also, ADP is working on the Microsoft Exchange server conversion to O365, all websites will be converted, MFA rolling out across the County using Gatekeeper for a comprehensive, password-less solution and server-based systems are moving to secure cloud environments. Lastly, ADP is using CrowdStrike and Endpoint to protect the County infrastructure.

Voice votes: 9 ayes, 1 absent, 0 abstain. Motion carried.

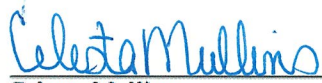
There was no action taken after Executive Session.

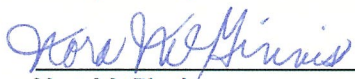
BEING NO FURTHER MOTION TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, Chuck Walder, motioned to adjourn.

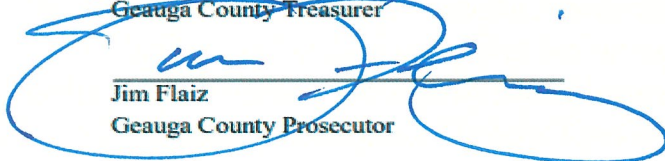
