#### ADP Mission Statement and Ohio Revised Code of creation

#### **Mission Statement**

To provide the highest level of technology in the most effective and efficient manner in the most realistic timeframe for the most reasonable cost. Advising agencies of new technologies, deploying equipment in a timely fashion, coordinating procurement, system implementation, and maintenance. Finally playing a key role in your business process attempting to improve competitiveness, efficiency, and communications.

#### **Ohio Revised Code**

#### 307.84 Establishing automatic data processing board.

The board of county commissioners of any county may, by resolution, establishes a county automatic data processing board. The board shall consist of the county treasurer or the county treasurer's representative, the county recorder or the county recorder's representative, the clerk of the court of common pleas or the clerk's representative, a member or representative of the board of county commissioners chosen by the board, two members or representatives of the board of elections chosen by the board of elections one of whom shall be a member of the political party receiving the greatest number of votes at the most recent general election for the office of governor and one of whom shall be a member of the political party receiving the second greatest number of votes at such an election, if the board of elections desires to participate, and the county auditor or the county auditor's representative who shall serve as secretary. The members of the county automatic data processing board may by majority vote add to the board any additional members whose officers use the facilities of the board.

After the initial meeting of the county automatic data processing board, no county office shall purchase, lease, operate, or contract for the use of any automatic or electronic data processing or record-keeping equipment, software, or services without prior approval of the board.

As used in sections <u>307.84</u> to <u>307.846</u> of the Revised Code, "county office" means any officer, department, board, commission, agency, court, or other office of the county, other than a board of county hospital trustees.

Herein please find the Geauga County Automatic Data Processing (ADP) Board's 2021 Annual Report. In addition to fulfilling its primary mission of providing Information Technology to Geauga County and other public entities, ADP was called upon to assist with enhancing the County's cybersecurity to defend County offices and employee data. ADP has worked to increase awareness, training and defend Geauga County's government so it may continue operations and still serve the taxpayers.

ADP through its Geauga Connected initiative produced a new website for Bainbridge Township. Geauga Connected is a service that makes affordable manageable and feature-packed websites available to eligible political subdivisions. With Geauga Connected, ADP helps link local governments with their residents, keeping them connected and informed.

In August, ADP's Geauga Connected unveiled a new website for ADP. ADP's website has been modernized for an improved user interface to better serve its constituents. ADP can now showcase its services to provide advanced technological tools and support for the County.

In addition to the ADP website, ADP has seen a series of long-term initiatives come to fruition and continues in its endeavor for a wholesale revamping of Geauga County's internet presence. At the core of this initiative is to host these websites using a cloud-based server through an outside source to keep data private and safe across on-line infrastructure, platforms and applications.

Internal to the county, ADP's eSuite presence continues to grow, this portal extension of the county's enterprise resource planning (ERP) tool offering human resource (HR) and benefits information and documentation to employees online, thus reducing paper flow and labor overhead and giving the employee control of their personal information.

On behalf of the entire ADP team, a special thank you to the ADP Board for their continued involvement, confidence, support, and guidance. ADP remains committed to improvement, transparency, and serving the needs of its external and internal customers.




#### The 2021 Infrastructure

The IT environment is composed of 3 Main Campuses, 3 primary Satellite locations and various smaller satellite locations. 169 Servers provide Business Applications, email, file storage and printer services to over 900 end users. Tying all this together are 79 managed Cisco L2 and L3 Switches, 11 routers and firewalls in a backbone/campus environment, supporting 68 Virtual Lan (VLANS) that insures both performance and speed requirements of high-speed disk/file system access (10Gbit). The Wireless Infrastructure 85 Meraki Access Points placed in county facilities providing for central management. The 3 main campus sites are Connected by way of fiber and configured in a 'ring' topology to reduce downtime in the event of fiber leg outage.

In 2021, DoIT focused on enhancing and augmenting our county-wide cyber security protocols, methods, and processes.


ADP Chief Administrator Walder has made cybersecurity the critical enhancement of ADP DoIT's mission to efficiently and effectively manage Geauga County's technology.

DoIT has advanced Mr. Walder's commitment to cybersecurity resilience by dedicating assets, creativity, and funding to an overall focus on awareness, training and development, and defensive hardening. This call for action focused on tackling the immediate threat of ransomware and on building a more creative and robust workforce and partner relationships.

DoIT has adopted the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity framework as the basis for DoIT's methodology.
